## **There are 3 Easy Ways to Vote This Year:**

- 1. Return Your Mail-In Ballot.** If you've already received an  
absentee ballot, please return it immediately. It must be  
received by 8 pm on Tuesday, November 3. If you can't mail  
your ballot, you can drop it off at your local election office.
- 2. Vote Early In Person.** Early voting dates range from  
Oct. 20–Nov. 1, but may vary by municipality. To find out  
when and where you can vote early, visit

- 3. Vote Safely on Election Day, Nov. 3.** If you can't vote early,  
grab your mask and hand sanitizer, and join your community
